**SCOPE:** This policy applies to Chelan-Douglas Regional Support Network/Prepaid Health Plan (CDRSN/PHP) and its contractors (agencies/providers), and subcontractors (referred to as contractors or agencies or providers throughout this policy).

**PURPOSE:** To inform enrollees of any incentive plan

**DEFINITIONS:** “Incentive Plan” means: Any healthcare financing arrangement in which the contracted physician receives some manner of payment, reward, or benefit from limiting care to Medicaid enrollees.

**POLICY:** The CDRSN/PIHP ensures it does not operate any physician incentive plan as described in 42 CFR 422.208; and does not contract with any subcontractor operating such a plan. The CDRSN/PIHP incorporates this value into its contract documents with physicians and with entities which utilize physicians to provide Medicaid services to enrollees.

**PROCEDURE:** The CDRSN/PIHP incorporates this value into its contract documents with providers and with entities which utilize physicians to provide Medicaid services to enrollees. Contracted providers ensure this is reflected on site monitoring tools and education curricula.
